III. Zero Teen Fatalities: Kevin Moore (Zero Teen Fatalities Coordinator): kmmoore@dps.state.nv.us
Every state has to have a teen driving program. This is mandated by the Federal government. It is directed towards 15-20 Year Olds. 6% if the driving population gets into 14% of the crashes. There is a contest that uses social media such as Twitter and Instagram to get the word out about safe driving habits. Students register to be a part of this. ZTF counts the times that someone hashtags "#stayingundead". They will pay teens up to \$1000.00 (first place last year was from 350 tweets) Second place is \$500.00. Schools can also get money. There is an adult advisor, but it is teen run at the school level. When students register they will get swag. The winning school can get \$5000.00. They have challenges throughout the year. The next one coming up is designing a bulletin board. After this is a PSA 30 second TV commercial that will be aired in Nevada. The program from the winning school does not need to be a teacher. They will take the top 100 students from Northern Nevada to go to driver's ed. at Las Vegas Motor Speedway.

What can ZTF do for us on, or before Grad. Night? They can do lectures, talks, set up a booth, etc. Another idea is to set up a demonstration so that students can try on DUI goggles. We also discussed "Every 15 Minutes" where the Grim Reaper would come to Carson High and pull kids out of class every 15 minutes to represent how many students die from car accidents. There was also a suggestion of doing a DUI Crash simulation at CHS. Mr. Moore is also open to other suggestions in order to help in any way he can.
