a. Scholarships

Although, we don't necessarily need her approval since we are selling them at the craft fair. This will be a \$200.00 investment on our part. John would like two, 2 x 4 banners so that we can display them at the Craft Fair, when we go to Walmart, and on the day of the event itself. Sign-Pro will possibly redo the date yearly. John will check how much it would cost for a good quality sign with removable dates. We will spend up to \$50.00 on appropriate signage.

Darla passed out **raffle tickets** for us to sell. Some prizes are Night in the Country, a Hot August Night gift basket, & a Family of 4, one-day park hopper tickets for Disneyland. Darla is working on more raffle prizes. She will let us know of them as soon as she finds out.

On Jan. 16, 23, & 30, 9:00-12:00 we will sit out in front of Walmart to sell raffle tickets.
