III. Approval of Minutes from May 10, 2016: Kim motioned to approve them. Deanna seconded it.
IV. Treasurer's report: Three treasurer's report. Beginning balance in May of \$20,712.70. Ending balance as of $5 / 31 / 16$ of $\$ 30,607.51$. Wendy motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report, and Kim seconded.
V. New News

## A. Who is staying on for next year?

i. Busses:
